#### A YEAR OF FIGHTING ANTISEMITISM



Following the horrific attacks on October 7, Jewish communities worldwide faced the dual challenges of grappling with the tragedy and supporting our friends and family in Israel, all while confronting antisemitism on college campuses.

# University of Miami Hillel immediately responded by:

- Bringing together over 600 Jewish 'Canes and community members for a vigil at the Braman Miller Center for Jewish Life
- Providing resources and transportation so students could attend the Greater Miami Jewish Federation's rallies, the March for Israel in D.C., and lobby at the Florida State Capitol's Israel Day
- Working with UM's Police Department to ensure Hillel's building, events, and students were safe
- Empowering our students to speak with campus administration about combatting antisemitism
